

MEASURING KICKS

ACTIVITY OVERVIEW

Students use formal or informal units to measure distances of kicks.

CURRICULUM

- MATHS · 1 - AC9M1M02
- MATHS · 2 - AC9M2M01

MATERIALS

- Printed A3 playing field
- Range of informal units for students to measure e.g., counters, unifix blocks, MABs, paperclips, paper streamers, straws.



LEARNING INTENTIONS

- Know how to use informal units to measure length.
- Compare and order length using informal units.

SUCCESS CRITERIA

- I can place units end to end to measure the length of lines.
- I can compare and order the length of lines.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Provide students with an A3 printed field.
2. Have students select appropriate units to measure the distance of the kicks.
3. Have students compare and order the distance of kicks.
