INSTRUCTIONS

1. Trace around your hand on green paper 12 times or use the template provided.
2. Carefully cut each of your handprints out.
3. Glue your handprints around the rim of a paper plate to make a circle.
4. Decorate your wreath with red paper poppies and a banner.
