NSW Northern A big month for the Northern Corridor

The month of November attracted massive numbers at NRL Game Development activities across the Northern Corridor. In collaboration with the Newcastle Knights, the Newcastle team completed 7x Stage 1 League-tag events across 6 LGA's. The events connected seven Hunter Junior Rugby League Clubs and saw the largest ever gala day in the Hunter. Over the 7 events we engaged 191 teams, 73 schools and 1775 participants.







On the Central Coast, our team ran four stage 2 & 3 league-tag gala days across all of the Central Coast PSSA Zones. These events saw a total of 3200 students participate in League Tag across 38 primary schools. The kids were also lucky enough to meet NRLW Sydney Roosters Star Jayme Fressard!

In North Sydney, the annual Kids v Cops at Barker College Tag Day saw 6 schools take part and included Marsden HS, Asquith Girls, Knox Grammer, Barker College, Oakhill college and Kur-in-gai HS. Brad Fittler from the NRL attended on the day to support the great event.
